On behalf of the Sun City Shadow Hills Board of Directors, we would like to welcome you to the community. We look forward to meeting you, whether it be walking down the street, at the pool or at a community function.

The Board of Directors operates and governs the Homeowners Association. The Board is elected (from the community and by the community), to oversee the daily functions and financial responsibilities of the Association. The Board is also responsible for maintaining members' compliance with established Rules and Regulations and Bylaws of the Association.

Our community website (www.scshca.com) is the official communication channel between the Board of Directors and membership. Upcoming activities, events, important announcements, a community calendar, Bylaws, architectural review forms, and volunteer committee information can all be found there. The website provides ready answers to most questions asked by homeowners. But if you don't find the information you need, click on "Ask a Question" to receive answers from your Information Advisory Committee, HOA Board and/or management. Please take time as soon as possible to login and register at www.scshca.com and familiarize yourself with this great resource and get to know your community and neighbors.

Another excellent way to stay informed and up to date is to sign up for the Monday "Email Blasts". You will begin receiving weekly, Monday Email Blasts and occasional critical alerts, on an as needed basis. To receive this email blast you need to complete the online form by going to www.scshca.com, logging in, and clicking on Email Blast.

The View, our monthly magazine, features a calendar of events, activities, and feature stories about your neighbors.

As a resident, you may have some ideas on how you would like to improve your property. The specific provisions regarding what can and cannot be done to your property is covered in the Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, CC&R's and Design Rules provided to you during the home purchase process; copies are also available on the community website. The Design Review Committee evaluates your plans for the exterior like landscaping, repairs, remodeling, painting, decks, fences, trees, and replacements roofs. All modifications to the exterior of your property *must* be submitted to the Design Review Committee for approval *before* any work begins. Its purpose is to protect our scenic environment and maintain the value of our homes. If work is started without prior approval, the homeowner risks being cited for a covenant violation and may be required to alter or remove the changes.







# Subscribing on your iPhone or iPad

- 1. Open the "Podcasts" app included with your iPhone or iPad.
- 2. Click on the "Search" button and type in "sun city shadow hills" in the search bar. In the results, click on "Sun City Shadow Hills Podcast" under Shows.
- 3. Click on the "+ Follow" button. The Sun City Shadow Hills Podcast will be added to "Library" and the latest episode will download. New episodes will automatically be downloaded to your iPhone or iPad.
- 4. You can listen to past episodes by clicking on "Episodes".














This online visitor management system allows you to have the ability to manage your visitor list for the community entry gates, view your guest history, manage your users and vehicles and receive real-time text/email notifications when guest are registered or guest passes are issued or denied.

Please use this temporary registration code issued at the HOA office during registration and follow the three simple steps below to register and begin using this useful management system:

# Step 1

- Login to: https://community.dwellinglive.com
- Click on "I have a one-time use registration code"
- Enter your temporary code
- Complete the registration process. You will be automatically logged in.

## Step 2

- Select [My Account] to:
- · Set up/edit account users including contact information
- Login email and password editing
- Text and email notification preferences
- Edit call-in password to verify identify when calling the gate (if applicable)

# Step 3

- Select [Home] to:
- Manage your temporary, permanent, restricted and party guest lists
- Prioritize phone numbers for contact by gate attendant
- Please use caution with permanent guests!

Exisiting homeowners may request a temporary code online at www.scshca.com/dwellinglivecode and then follow steps 1-3 above.



There are three possible ways for a vendor to gain access onto Sun City Shadow Hills property, for the purpose of providing services to residents.

# Program 1:

- Vendors not equipped with transponders are allowed 5 Vendor Service Passes per month, per company, per vehicle.
- The homeowner MUST call one of the gates every time vendor access is needed and place the vendor on their guest list by company name.
- The homeowner is NOT responsible for the vendor while on Sun City Shadow Hills property.

## **Program 2:**

- The NON-Transponder Program allows the vendor to gain access to the property 5 service passes
  per month, per company, per vehicle, without the homeowner calling the gate.
- Vendors are required to complete the Non-Transponder Program Form providing current registration, insurance, and a valid driver's license. The vendor is responsible for ensuring three documents are current and provided to Edward to remain active on homeowner's vendor list.
- Vendors registered to this program are placed on the resident's Permanent Vendor list. The
  homeowner does not need to call the gate prior to entry, nor is the homeowner responsible for the
  vendor while on Sun City Shadow Hills property.

# **Program 3 (Vendor Program):**

- The Transponder Program allows vendors unlimited access privileges through all 6 gates in Sun City Shadow Hills ONLY during vendor hours.
- Vendors are required to complete the Transponder Program Form, provide, and maintain current vehicle registration, insurance, a valid driver's license, and pay any required fees.
- Vendors registered to this program are placed on the "Transponder Equipped Vendor List" which contains over 600 vendors. The list is available online at www.scshca.com/frontgate.
- If the vehicle equipped with the transponder is unavailable, the vendor must use the guest lane and acquire one of the 5 Vendor Service Passes. The homeowner is NOT responsible for the vendor while on Sun City Shadow Hills property.

Vendors may contact Edward Nunez, Facilities Coordinator, to obtain the Vendor Access Program forms, (760) 345-4349, ext. 2401 or you may obtain a copy at either manned guardhouse, located at the entrance of Phase I or Phase III.

As with any program, special circumstances will, from time to time, present themselves. Please contact our Facilities Coordinator at (760) 345-4349 ext. 2401, and they will work with you toward an equitable resolution in the best interests of our residents.



#### **Vendor Access Limitations**

Vendors, with a valid pass, may be granted access into SCSHCA, except on Sundays, to perform routine (non-emergency) outdoor residential construction or maintenance service according to the following schedule:

- Monday through Friday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm
- Saturday 8:00 am to 6:00 pm (or as permitted by City of Indio or County of Riverside Ordinances)

No access and no work is allowed on the following nationally observed holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- President's Day
- Memorial Day
- Juneteenth
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

Emergency exceptions will be considered; please call the Jefferson Main Gate at (760) 345-4458.

**Mail Tubes:** Mail tubes are for Association-approved items such as The View and notices preapproved by the HOA. Tubes are located next to your mailbox.

**The View:** Our community magazine is delivered at the beginning of each month to your mail tube. It is a monthly calendar of events and activities in the clubhouses and classes at the fitness centers. Clubs, resident groups and organizations provide monthly updates and contact information. It also includes feature stories about your neighbors and other articles of interest in SCSH. It is advertiser supported.

**Sun City Shadow Hills Website:** Our community website, www.scshca.com, is the premiere source of up-to-date information about the community, clubs, organizations, committees and special events. The website provides ALL the information you need, including the CC&R Rules and Regulations and other Design Guidelines, you may want to periodically review. Login and register today! YOUR INFORMATION IS NEVER GIVEN TO ANYONE FROM THIS SITE.

**Community Directory:** Your name and address, phone number and e-mail address will only be added with your permission. Information changes can be done on-line.

**Library:** Our free lending library is located in the Montecito Clubhouse in the front lobby. It is run and managed by community volunteers.

**Trash and Recycling:** Burrtec is the service provider for trash. Pick-up is on Tuesday. You may put your bins out on Monday after 4 pm. Bins need to be back in your garage by 10 pm on Tuesday. For more information on Burrtec, see the enclosed flyer.

**Events:** The Lifestyle Department (offices in the Montecito Clubhouse) is responsible for assisting clubs and residents with all scheduling of events. There are kiosks located at the Montecito Clubhouse lobby and in cubical bins at the Santa Rosa Clubhouse that have up-to-date flyers of all events/activities.

**Lifestyle Desk:** The Lifestyle Desk is in the Montecito Clubhouse lobby. There are many volunteer opportunities at this desk like selling tickets to events, answering questions and providing assistance to residents as needed.

**Computers:** There is one computer for community use located near the library in the Montecito Clubhouse.

**Wi-Fi:** If you are using your own laptop or mobile device, wi-fi is available at both clubhouses. Visit the front desk to receive the login credentials.

# Pool & Spa

Children ages 4 - 16 are permitted only in the outdoor pool, not in the spa.

Please note that pool hours for children rotate at each clubhouse according to the season:

## November 1 - April 30

Montecito Outdoor Pool: 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm
Santa Rosa Outdoor Pool: 9:00 am - 12:00 pm

# May 1 - October 31

Montecito Outdoor Pool: 9:00 am - 12:00 pm

Santa Rosa Outdoor Pool: 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm

We ask that everyone observe these important safety and hygiene measures:

- Floats, balls, toys, innertubes, and inflatable devices are not permitted unless required for medical reasons. (You may use swim pool "Noodles", "Noodle Chairs" and kickboards)
- No diving, running, or jumping.
- No hanging/sitting/climbing on pool lane dividers. No swinging/ hanging/sitting on handrails.
- Please shower before entering the pool or spa, and re-shower after using any suntan lotion before re-entering the pool or spa. Suntan oil is not permitted.
- No bandages of any type may be worn in the pool or spa.
- Incontinent persons of any age may not use the pool or spa at any time. Diapers of any type also are not permitted.

# **Proper Attire – Food and Beverages – Pets – No Smoking**

- Proper swimming attire is required in the pool or spa: no cut-offs, underwear, or street clothing.
- Food, canned beverages, or plastic cups may be used in the sun lounge areas and wherever tables are provided. Glass containers of any kind are forbidden.
- Food and drinks are not permitted in the pool or spa, or within 4 feet of the water.
- Pets may not enter the fenced pool areas except for permissible reasonable accommodation.
- Smoking is forbidden inside the pool/spa area.
- Chairs and umbrellas must be a minumum of four feet from the pools/spas.
- Umbrellas must be properly secured.



# **Fitness Center**

- Please sign in with your resident card each day at the Front Desk for admission to the Fitness Center.
- An Informed Consent Form must be signed by each resident before using the fitness center and indoor/outdoor pool area.
- Using cell phones is not permitted in the workout area.
- Proper fitness attire (including athletic shoes) is required on the gym floor.

Please maintain reasonable decorum in all clubhouse facilities and be considerate of others. Loud or erratic behavior is never acceptable.

# **Guidelines for Guests**

Please sign in each day at the Front Desk for admission to the Fitness Center and pool/spa area.

Guests must adhere to all above safety and hygiene guidelines as well as rules for personal conduct.

- If not accompanied by a resident, each guest must present a Guest Card to use the facilities.
- All guests require a wristband to use the facilities from April 1 30.
- Guests unaccompanied by a resident may only use the Fitness Center after 12 pm from November 1 – April 30.
- Guests may be asked to relinquish the use of any fitness equipment when residents are waiting to use it.



Our community is very pet friendly. Dog walking is encouraged, and there are dog parks located in Phase 1, Division 7, and Phase 3, Division 16, as well as the common area surrounding the Jefferson Front Gate (Phase 1). Residents are also allowed to walk their dog(s) along (up to) 9 feet of the grassy area where parts of the golf course touch pavement and cross the street. One exception is where Avenida Sombra intersects with Sun City Boulevard on the north side of Avenida Sombra. The curb there is painted red to signify no parking or dog walking, as this area has been determined to be a safety risk.

Many residents have thought that the grassy areas touching the street were not part of the golf course but when Sun City Shadow Hills was developed, any portion of the property that was designated golf course by Del Webb/Pulte was, in fact, legally deeded as golf course.

# **Current HOA regulations read:**

2.20.4 of Rules & Regulations

"Pets are not permitted on the golf course at any time. Exception: Other than no dog walking at Avenida Sombra where Avenida Sombra meets Sun City Blvd. behind hole number 7, all other areas where the golf course crosses a street, you may walk your dog along the edge of the Golf Course as long as you and your dog do not walk beyond nine feet (9') from the edge of the street or sidewalk."

#### Accepted by the Board 1-29-18

The HOA strongly encourages pet owners to read those rules and regulations pertaining to pets within our community. The rules can be found in the Sun City Shadow Hills Community & Telephone Directory.

Pet owners are responsible for the removal and proper disposal of their pet's litter from the common areas as well as the pet parks. Failure to comply with the pet rules are a violation of 2.20.4 of Rules & Regulations and may result in a fine.

provided that there is no other moving violation by the same driver in rolling 12-month periods since the date of the last citation.

- If there is a second moving violation by the same driver within one year since the date of the last moving violation, then the suspended \$100 fine, plus the new fine, is due at the same time of the second moving violation. Any additional moving violations by the same driver in rolling 12-month periods since the date of the last citation may be subject to the listed fines being doubled.
- For renting and leasing violations, each-and-every-day a violation exists shall constitute a separate and distinct violation.
- Renting/Leasing in violation of the governing documents, a qualified Rental Program Administrator may not be a homeowner. The Rental Program Administrator must notify the HOA and complete any appropriate documentation for any rental agreement before the rental commencement date. The Rental Program Administrator is responsible to collect any fees and/or management fees. In addition, he/she is responsible for any repairs and maintenance to the dwelling unit. All short-term rental agreements must comply with Chapter 37 of the City of Indio Municipal Code relating to Short-term vacation rentals.

The costs incurred by the Association, if any, may be added to the listed fines. Any second or subsequent violations of the same rules, regulation, or other provision in the Governing Documents by an owner, resident, tenant guest or vendor who has been previously fined, for the same-violation, may be subject to the listed fines being doubled. \*

Fine amount is \$25 for the first offense, would be \$50 for the second offense, \$100 for the third offense, etc. Fine amount of \$100 for the first offense, would be \$200 for the second offense, \$400 for the third offense, etc.

Requests for exemptions are accepted at the City of Indio Finance Department located at 100 Civic Center Mall (located directly across from the Indio Library), and the Indio Senior Center located at 45700 Aladdin St.

In order to process your request in a timely manner, please bring in the following:

- 2. Proof of age (driver's license, state ID, or birth certificate), or
- 3. Certification from SSI, and
- 4. Copies of the most recent utility bill from each of the following utility companies that service your residence:
