Bulk Cable Is Coming To Sun City Shadow Hills

I am pleased to announce that the Association's Board of Directors and Time Warner Cable are finally ready to have Bulk Cable available to the homeowners of SCSH. It has been along time coming and after many negotiations, the deal has been finalized.

On October 15, 2007, a town hall meeting was held to present the package and to answer questions. Thank you to the many 400+ homeowners who attended. Some questions arose that were in need of further investigation and answer. The Board and TWC are now in the process of finalizing the Q& A mailer that will be sent to every homeowner no later than January 2008. In the mailer you will also have a form that needs to be completed; the acceptance or declination. Once you have accepted the bulk billing and once there are 1400 homes that have accepted this program, your bulk cable will be added to your monthly homeowner assessment billing for \$37.00/month. If we do not achieve acceptance by 1400 homes, the monthly bulk billing to you will be \$39.00/month. What a great bargain when you see all the TV channels, music selections, HBO and Showtime choices included.

More information is to follow. PLEASE do not delay in completing the form in the mailer. This form will be counted toward the number of homes that determine the monthly billing you will receive. Thank you for your patience over the last 2+ years while progress was made to design this program.

Question: Why doesn't Pulte put fences or gates with locks at the end of the American Canal at Varner and 40th streets?

Answer: Since Pulte doesn't own the land on either side of the canal, it has no control over the fencing issue and can't just erect a fence at its expense. The Bureau of Land Management has the control over these areas.

Question: In October and early November some of the grass on the golf course got quite tall. What happened?

Answer: One of the large mowers broke. It has been repaired, though, so things are pretty much back to normal and aren't the green lawns pretty?

Question: How many residents actually live here year around?

Answer: About 73% of the residents live here year around, leaving approximately 27% who are part-time residents or "Snow Birds" as they're often called. This Sun City differs from Sun City Palm Desert in that about 41% still work full time; in the other Sun City most residents are retired. About 8% work part time here, leaving approximately 51% who are completely retired.

Question: I see our golf club Shadows Restaurant had a dinner for December. Is this something the restaurant plans on doing on a regular basis?

Answer: Yes, the idea is to utilize our restaurant so that it becomes a fun meeting place for our residents. By selling tickets in advance, the restaurant won't have to worry about taking a loss. By patronizing our restaurant and golf course, we keep the income coming in and are able to offset our expenses more successfully.

Note: Volunteers are still needed to act as Captains for the various divisions of our Sun City. These Captains will help with Emergency Preparedness and with promoting better communication in the community. If you are new to the community, here is a great way get involved. As the holidays are wrapping up it is time to get back out on the court, hopefully with some new equipment. The USTA leagues will be starting soon. Our Captains are finalizing their rosters and if you have not signed up for a team

there still may be time. This also is the time to start working on your footwork. The proper footwork will get you in the right position to hit your best shots consistently. Cardio Tennis is an excellent class for improved footwork. I also recommend the numerous classes in the Fitness Center; anything that will get your feet moving. Personally, if I cannot do Cardio Tennis I will pull out my jump rope and do some footwork drills on the court. When I watch our Members play I do not see the feet moving as much as we should. I guarantee if you improve your footwork, you will improve your match play.

TENNIS TIP

Backhand Volleys

Give the "safe" signal

A common flaw in many club players' backhand volleys is their tendency to chop down on the ball, allowing the racquet head to drop below wrist level. Usually, the result is a volley hit off-balance with so little pace and control that it catches the net. To hit a more effective backhand volley, keep your wrist firm and, instead of chopping down on the ball, flatten out your volleying motion. Think of yourself as a baseball umpire giving a "safe" signal when you hit the ball. As you punch forward on your volley, your free arm should extend away from your body simultaneously in the opposite direction to help you maintain your balance and keep your volleying motion crisp and compact. By hitting "safe" and sure backhand volleys, you'll find yourself scoring more often at the net.





Welcome to 2008 at Sun City Shadow Hills. We hope you all had a safe and happy Holiday Season!!

There are some new things happening this year in our Community. January begins golf cart registration for residents who are non-golfers. You will need to stop by the HOA office and present a copy of your liability insurance in order to obtain decals for your cart. You will receive a numbered decal that will stay on your cart permanently and a "year" decal that will be replaced each January.

Some Reminders:

The Rules and Regulations (page 6) of the Association require (for safety measures) that garage and address lights be illuminated from dusk to dawn 365 days of the year. We have addressed the issue of keeping garage and address lights operating in the past and we want to inform you that the HOA office is now selling light bulbs for garage lights and address lights in the first phase. In the second phase they will have garage light bulbs, address light bulbs and ceiling (certain types) light bulbs for the interior of your homes.

Community patrol is providing the HOA office with a list of homes that have outside lights that are burned out. Residents will be receiving courtesy letters to notify them of lights that are out and will be allowed thirty (30) days to replace the bulbs. If you do not live in the Community full time or you are not able to change the bulbs yourself, you may want to contact a handyman to replace bulbs for you.

Trash cans may be put out at 4:00 pm on the day before collection and must be taken in by 10:00 pm on the day of collection.

If you have questions or need assistance with anything, please contact the HOA office, the staff is available to assist you Monday through Friday from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm and from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. If there is an after hours emergency, please call (am waiting for the number)

The mail tubes are going to have blocks installed in the back to keep papers from building up inside. Please remember that the mail tubes are for Association business ONLY and cannot be used for soliciting by vendors or residents.



Please remember that dogs are not permitted on the property of other owners. Properties on corner lots own the front along the street and down the side on the adjoining street. These are not public or common areas to be used for "walking" dogs. Please do not allow your dogs to urinate or defecate in these areas.

Design Review

Water conservation is a critical issue here in the desert. Most people do not realize how little water it really takes to keep plants alive and healthy. According to the Coachella Valley Water District, during the months of January and February, irrigation times should be set to no more than a total of five minutes per day. When we experience periods of heavy rains and cool temperatures, it takes several days for the ground to dry.

It is also critical that you direct your sprinklers away from common walls to keep water from intruding into neighboring yards.

This table shows the average number of minutes a grass lawn typically needs watering each day. Watering times can vary significantly based on sprinkler efficiency and soil conditions. Reduce watering times gradually to determine the amount needed for your landscape.

We see a number of trees that fall during windy periods because they are top heavy and the ground is saturated. Trees should be laced (thinned) and properly staked routinely to keep this from happening.

"Trees Need Year-Round Maintenance"

I wanted to remind everyone that all the trees planted by Del Webb when your home is being built need maintenance frequently. Maintenance for a tree involves much more than just trimming. When your trees are planted they are staked with 2" stakes and bubbler heads that are near the base of the tree to allow water to reach the new roots. As the tree gets larger, the stakes may have to be moved farther away from the tree trunk and the bubblers may have to be moved farther away from the tree to allow for the growing roots. The tree stakes also need replacing over time due to their being in the moist ground and eventually getting weak from the moisture. Trees need trimming on a regular basis to keep them from getting top heavy and more likely to blow over in strong winds.

All trees are different and require different amounts of watering. Over watering does more damage than good. There are a variety of ways to stake a tree as it grows. Please consult a qualified landscaper to give advice on the correct way to stake your tree as it grows. One of the most common mistakes is to tie a tree so tightly to stakes that it doesn't allow the tree to "move" with the wind. As a tree moves in the wind it actually makes the trunk and roots stronger. For more information on staking, watering and maintenance of your tree year round, please consult www.cvwd.com or other websites that include detailed instructions on the best way to care for your trees as they grow.
