

Pool Guidelines

Montecito Indoor Pool

1. All residents must make a reservation to use the pool. Spas will remain closed. See pg. 5 for reservation details.
2. Reservations may be made up to one week in advance. Maximum of one (1) person per reservation.
3. Residents may only arrive 5 minutes before their scheduled time to use the pool. Please do not arrive earlier than 5 minutes. No one is to enter the building at any time.
4. Each resident is to enter the indoor pool through the outside door adjacent to the main entrance. The door will have signage. There will also be signage indicating the location of an outside waiting area near the main entrance of the fitness center. Markers on the floor indicating 6' foot separation will also be displayed. The Fitness Center and Clubhouse will remain closed and residents are not allowed to enter.
5. There will be one table near the pool steps and exit doors where the swimmer can place their belongings. This table will be wiped down frequently.
6. Reservations will be for 30 minutes. Swimmers must come ready to swim and must leave immediately following their 30-minute time. Each resident must leave the area within 5 minutes. If a swimmer is late their time will not be extended but must end on the appointed time.
7. Each resident is to exit the indoor pool through the double doors to the hallway and then through the West outdoor pool gate near the Bocce courts. Doors for entering and exiting the pool will be marked off with signage.
8. Showers will not be available. Locker-rooms are not available, only the single-person bathroom in the hallway outside the indoor pool may be used.
9. There will be a 15-minute gap between reservations for staff to clean and maintain the area.
10. Staff will sanitize all high touch areas, including handrails, restroom surfaces, light switches, dispensers, faucets, and doorknobs, frequently.
11. All residents must wear a breathable face covering as soon as they exit their vehicle, while waiting to enter the pool area, and when returning to their vehicle. Face coverings are not required while swimming, but they are required at all other times. Any violators will be removed. If there are repeated violations the HOA will be forced to close the pools.
12. Residents are encouraged to bring hand sanitizer, and/or sanitizing wipes to sanitize hands before and after using the pool.
13. All water will be shut-off (including ice machine, if any). Residents must bring enough water to last the length of their reservation.
14. All outdoor furniture in pool area will be removed or stacked/chained in such a manner that furniture is rendered unusable. Residents are not allowed to bring their own furniture or pool chairs.
15. Residents must maintain social distancing.
16. No spectators allowed.

17. No events or gatherings of any kind.
18. Only SCSH members may use the pools. No guests allowed.
19. Access to the rest of the Fitness Center and Clubhouse is not permitted.

Montecito Outdoor Pool

1. All residents must make a reservation to use the pool. Spas will remain closed. See pg. 5 for reservation details.
2. Reservations may be made up to one week in advance. Maximum of one (1) person per reservation.
3. Residents may only arrive 5 minutes before their scheduled time to use the pool. Please do not arrive earlier than 5 minutes. No one is to enter the building at any time.
4. Each resident is to enter the outdoor pool through the pool gate by the breezeway. The pool gate will have signage and is located closest to the handicap door to the back of Fitness Center. There will also be signage indicating the location of an outside waiting area near the breezeway. Markers on the floor indicating 6' foot separation will also be displayed. The Fitness Center and Clubhouse will remain closed and residents are not allowed to enter.
5. There will be one table near the pool steps where the swimmer can place their belongings. This table will be wiped down frequently.
6. Reservations will be for 30 minutes. Swimmers must come ready to swim and must leave immediately following their 30-minute time. Each resident must leave the area within 5 minutes. If a swimmer is late their time will not be extended but must end on the appointed time.
7. Each resident is to exit the outdoor pool through the West pool gate near the Bocce courts. Doors for entering and exiting the pool will be marked off with signage.
8. Showers will not be available. Locker-rooms are not available, only the outdoor pool restrooms may be used.
9. There will be a 15-minute gap between reservations for staff to clean and maintain the area.

Santa Rosa Outdoor Pool

1. All residents must make a reservation to use the pool. Spas will remain closed. See pg. 5 for reservation details.
2. Reservations may be made up to one week in advance. Maximum of one (1) person per reservation.
3. Residents may only arrive 5 minutes before their scheduled time to use the pool. Please do not arrive earlier than 5 minutes. No one is to enter the building at any time.
4. Each resident is to enter the outdoor pool from the West pool gate near Tennis Court #6. The pool gate will have signage. There will also be signage indicating the location of an outside waiting area near the outdoor pool. Markers on the floor indicating 6' foot separation will also be displayed. The Fitness Center and Clubhouse will remain closed and residents are not allowed to enter.
5. There will be one table near the pool steps where the swimmer can place their belongings. This table will be wiped down frequently.
6. Reservations will be for 30 minutes. Swimmers must come ready to swim and must leave immediately following their 30-minute time. Each resident must leave the area within 5 minutes. If a swimmer is late their time will not be extended but must end on the appointed time.
7. Each resident is to exit the outdoor pool through either the West pool gate near Tennis Court #6 or the pool gate nearest to the North Course Golf Pro Shop. Doors for entering and exiting the pool will be marked off with signage.
8. Showers will not be available. Locker-rooms are not available, only the outdoor pool restrooms may be used.
9. There will be a 15-minute gap between reservations for staff to clean and maintain the area.
10. Staff will sanitize all high touch areas, including handrails, restroom surfaces, light switches, dispensers, faucets, and doorknobs frequently.
11. All residents must wear a breathable face covering as soon as they exit their vehicle, while waiting to enter the pool area, and when returning to their vehicle. Pool Guidelines

Reservations

Reservations can be made via phone-call only.

For reservations for the **Santa Rosa Outdoor Pool**, please call the Santa Rosa Front Desk at (760) 345-4349 Ext. 2201 between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Phone lines are open Monday through Friday.

For reservations for the **Montecito Indoor or Outdoor Pool**, please call the Montecito Front Desk at (760) 345-4349 Ext. 2111 between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Phone lines are open Monday through Friday.

1. Reservations will be for 30 minutes. Swimmers must come ready to swim and must leave immediately following their 30-minute time. Each resident must leave the area within 5 minutes. Showers and locker rooms will not be available.
2. Reservation times are from 7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. (3:30 p.m. is the last reservation time). No open swim time or reservations are allowed before or after these times.
3. Maximum of one (1) person per reservation.
4. Reservations may be made up to one week in advance.
5. A resident may only have one reservation per day.
6. Same day reservations are permitted.
7. The pools must be reserved for cleaning and maintenance and the times must be placed on each reservation schedules. The Director of Facilities & Maintenance will submit these times to each Clubhouse and Fitness Director.
8. Failure to follow these rules and guidelines may lead to closure of all pools.
