

Minutes from Sept 21, 2020 meeting

Meeting Notes:

Connie advised the reason for a talk today.

Connie received about 11 emails with suggestions about ideas of entertainment in a safe mannerism since Riverside has relaxed some of the restrictions. Connie responded to emails by directing authors of emails to send recommendations to the HOA board members.

Lee attempted to review Riverside COVID restriction rules and rules appear to be confusing. Pat also concurred.

Connie advised that restrictions allowed AMC Theater, nail salons, barbershops, and restaurants to open.

Connie states that most of the emails suggested if we comply with social distancing and mask activities recommended can be safe.

If the board would allow shredding which can be a no-contact task, this can be a starting point in setting up activities. Therefore, we like to look at guidelines at what we can be set up safely.

Connie poses the question to Linda what does she think the board would consider for approval.

Linda said so far we have not been able to do anything. If the state moves our county from one zone to another we may be able to open up a little. We can put together a shortlist for her.

Connie suggested is having a drive-in theater would be a good idea to propose to HOA for approval.

We wish to be prepared with a recommendation if and when the community opens up therefore we need to start preparing now.

We previously looked at hosting a parking lot jazz event. Spacing etc was already planned out. This information can be proposed. Jerry was involved in figuring out spacing etc.

Lee suggested that as part of outdoor activities we can model what Palm Spring outdoor theater is doing. It is felt if we have one successful event, we can build on that. Pat wanted to know if the Toys for Tots drive still are being planned. At this point, there is no information on how the organization will proceed. The organization will need to provide safe guidelines. It was suggested that we make monetary gifts this year.
