

Coachella Valley Water District CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

CVWD has started work on the North Indio Regional Flood Control Project

Project benefits

- Protect homes and land in North Indio from regional flooding.
- Remove about 2,700 acres of land from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's mapped 100-year flood zone.
- Eliminate the mandatory flood insurance requirement in the area.

Project overview

- Connect existing stormwater channels within Sun City Palm Desert to existing channels in Sun City Shadow Hills.
- New channels will move flood water away from homes and ultimately into the Coachella Valley Stormwater Channel.

Impact to the community

- Project timeline: Winter 2022 through Summer 2024
- ◆ Typical Work hours: 7 a.m. to 3:30p.m. Monday to Friday. Work hours could change due to emergencies, weather or unexpected construction changes.
- CVWD will notify residents of any road closures or detours.
