And this is in regards to the parking lot sale tomorrow, we just want to make sure that part of the conversation I'm going to have is pertaining to the vendors and some, the other half is going to be pertaining to all the wonderful attendees that we're going to see tomorrow at our parking lot sale for the vendors, we just want to let you remind you let you know that you can begin loading in at 6:15. Final load in is at 7:30. And we will have some wonderful refreshments and doughnuts and coffee for just the vendors who's going to be participating we want to make sure we will have Southwest church that will be picking up the items between 11:45 and 12:00 that have not sold however, it is important for me to stress the items that they will not pick up that you would be responsible for either taking back or in discarding. So things that will not be picked up will be household chemicals, armoires mattresses, broken or damaged furniture, tires, dishwashers, old CRTs or TVs, printers, and fax machines. So if you have any of those items and they do not say all the new would be responsible for taking those back with you or we will be helping you to discard some of them. So what we want to say for our attendees, you would be there and from eight to 12 and you will have some amazing, amazing sites we have over 80 vendors that's going to be participating so bring you change in your in your nice smiles and we will see you there. Yes, we have to set check with the city and I know that the city of Indio at least twice a year has a donation or place where you can drop off old electronics and we can go ahead and get that information hopefully if we haven't by tomorrow we can give you the dates in terms of when they were going to be sponsoring that electronic...

We do have about 120 people signed up for the event, but no entries in terms of the golf cart parade we do have signups for the holiday golf cart parade, we're starting to get those in but for the holiday Halloween spooktacular we don't have any entries or at this particular time.

Okay, that might be a little bit of my fault because I have been telling people decorate your cards get ready for the Halloween spooktacular I didn't tell them that they needed to sign up for the spooktacular Parade. So that's a little bit of my fault because I know there's a lot of people that are don't decorate it I've seen some cards already decorated Halloween style. So I know you like to keep a track of that my fault my bad error on that. But if you are decorating your cart, and you can call Connie at the lifestyle desk or them then just let them know that you're going to be coming and attending the golf cart parade. If not, it's again it's my bad I just told everybody to decorate their carts and come on out and and have some fun we're going to do the parade up like we did for Fourth of July. And then we're going to finish back at the clubhouse and be ready for this spooktacular.

So I want to just to give the time line from four to five is going to be the golf cart parade, from five to six is going to be the refreshments and the appetizers, and from six to eight is going to be the DJ with the live live DJ night. So we do have it broken down but if you're there about 3:30 which are decorated golf cart parade, we can get you checked in and we can head down Sun City Boulevard.

But she's also been kind of filling in for the fitness center as a manager for the fitness center while we're in transition. So she has worked really really hard on this golf walk. And I think I'm pretty sure we're setting a record here.

We are, we sure are. We have 323 members signed up for this walk. So we're very excited. We just want to remind everyone to have fun when we're out there this this walk is scheduled for November 5 We start at 8am. We will be meeting behind the pro shop that's next to the shadows restaurant, you'll see a very nice big banner it'll say Sun City Shadow Hills annual golf walk, we'll meet you there. It should be all 18 holes, you don't have to walk all 18 holes. But if you do that's 5.2 miles of cart path. So it's a real nice walk. We're gonna have we hope to have real nice weather. Just a reminder, stay on the cart path. We don't want to walk on the grass, no vehicles, no pets. We're gonna have to water stations out one by the hole number five and hole number 15. Don't forget to pick up your T shirts at the Montecito fitness center. They're making phone calls now. Having everyone come pick up their shirts. Don't forget to wear them the day of the event. And just have fun. It's going to be a fun walk. We're going to have some small snack bags at the end of the walk and some cups with green juice, smoothies.

Nice. So you see we've got a lot of people Working on special events that are happening here in the community. We have a lot of snowbirds coming back. We are trying to take full advantage of the weather. I think Vanessa has ordered up a really nice day for those two events. So if it rains and thunders and pours still come out, because it's still a special event don't miss out. Anyway. Anything else, Vanessa?

Vanessa Ayon 10:24

Yes, we are gearing up to start our Fall Into Fitness program that starts on Monday, the 25th. We're no longer taking signups. I understand we have about 38 members signed up. So that'll be a very fun

program. And we'll have a nice little award ceremony in December after the program ends. So we're very excited for that. We have special fitness classes, specifically for the program.

It's a very gratifying position takes very little work. No, I'm just kidding. It takes a lot of work. So you got to have some time to do it. So hopefully we can get some people signed up. You can get in touch with Bob Israel. Or you can get in touch with Vanessa Island here at the HOA office on that. Vanessa, do you have something on that? No?

No, if you need a nomination form, if you you know happen to have last year call for candidates mailer, give us a call and we'll get you a nomination form. It's also posted on the website. So is the entire mailer.

Okay, good. So if you didn't get it, or at one to a different address, or if you're now this sign up to be a candidate is they have to be a resident by February . . .

. . . February 12. Okay, so if you're if you're here already, great. If you're coming in the future, or you know, friends that are coming, or you're listening to the podcast, and you haven't quite moved in yet, you just have to be here by February 12. And you can be a member of the board of directors, or any committee here. So let me go into another thing here, I wanted to talk about the ponds. So as you saw, we've been doing a lot of work on the ponds around the golf course. I know people are saying that they're starting to see a little bit of the toolies come back in there. Don't worry, don't worry, we have plenty of ideas on what's going to happen here. The the vendor of the contractor has actually given us some chemicals that are not harmful to the ducks, the animals, the fish, any of that stuff. So it only affects the toolies, which is good. And we're looking forward to having those lakes look real good. Next thing is and I find this to be a very important conversation. I received several phone calls from residents that walk early in the morning. Now what am I talking about early in the morning, I'm talking about 435 in the morning when it's still dark outside, and they walk sensitive Boulevard. Now they walk on the sidewalk, and they cross the streets in the crosswalks where they're supposed to. But we do have some residents that feel that because it's dark outside or maybe everybody's still sleeping, that they don't have to stop at stop signs. That is not the case, you still need to stop at the stop signs. It is not a free for all when it's dark. And I am worried because there's a couple of residents that said they came

very close to being hit in the crosswalk. I suggest that when you're out walking, if it's dark, wear some reflectors wear what I've seen a couple people out there with the little red lights on their arm, that flash. I got out there early in the morning, a couple days in a row just to see what was going on for my own self. As I saw security out there, and I saw I saw people go right through stop signs without even stopping. So it's, it's scary to the residents who would like to walk in peace and know that they're going to be safe and not have to worry about anything. So that's about all the information I have for you today. We have done the budget and the budget has gone to the finance and finance is making their suggestions to the board. The board will be discussing it on Monday morning in Executive Session, and we will be voting on the budget on Monday afternoon. Don't forget if you want to come and talk about anything that goes on here at Sun City Shadow Hills. To come to the board meeting at two o'clock in the Montecito ballroom.

I want the community to see the flowers when they come to the HOA office. We used to have a cigarette, what was it, a cigarette pot or whatever was there and I couldn't figure out why, an ashtray.
