This also includes the indoor fitness and indoor club activities. We are going to evaluate the system and tell you what's going on. We're hoping to have some outdoor classes available. Julie our fitness director will be working on that to see if we can get some outdoor classes for you. But as far as indoor activities, the association will not be holding any of those indoors. Ours staff members will be on hand at the fitness centers and the clubhouses. The club houses will remain open and the fitness centers will remain open. This is for you to protect yourself and be able to have those activities available to you. Please do not organize any activities through the clubs. If people want to gather and do their own, on their own, then you may do so in in the clubhouses. It just is one of those situations where we have a lot of people who are sick. And we're trying to get them better as soon as we possibly can. And the Board and I have made this decision. And, it's not an easy decision to make but it's one that we have to live with for right now.
