And, it'll be a good day to see and look.

Yeah, well this is a great opportunity. I attended the Creative Art Club Art Show last Saturday, and I don't know, there seemed like there were 50 different artists there, many of whom I think would do real well, getting their work shown to a wider audience. I attended the Camera Club show in the past, and I know there's a lot of great photographers here. And we've got a jewelry club. We've got, maybe there are quilters here who want to sell their quilts. I know the Writers Club, you know, there are people here who are books they want to sell. For all I know, there are people who design clothes. And I mean, art is a wide-ranging subject. And, this is a great opportunity to get your work shown outside of these walls here. So how much does it cost for someone to participate if they're interested?

That they progressed, you know where they, and their talent is developed to the point where they can have a wider audience. So anything else is going to be there?
