





 - BANDAGES
 - TRAUMA FIRST-AID SUPPLIES
 - TABLES & CHAIRS
 - GENERATORS/LIGHTS/ FANS



GENERATOR SUPPORT TEAM

- CONTROLS SIX x PORTABLE DUAL-FUEL GENERATORS
- DELIVER GENERATORS AS NEEDED
- KEEP GENERATORS FUELED and REFUELED
- RIG FLOOD LIGHTS AS NEEDED
- DIRECT GENERATOR TRAILER FROM MAINTENANCE YARD
 - TRAILER CONTAINS 2 X PORTABLE DUAL-FUEL GENERATORS
 - DELIVER EXTRA GASOLINE and PROPANE TANKS AS NEEDED
 - CAGED SUPPLY OF GASOLINE and PROPANE TANKS


2023 E.P.C. ACTIVATIONS

- DECEMBER 31, 2023: ATTENDEE SUFFERED AN OBSERVED FULL CARDIAC ARREST IN THE BALLROOM – NO PULSE OR RESPIRATIONS
- SIX (6) E.P.C. MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE IMMEDIATELY JUMPED TO ACTION ON BEHALF OF THE PATIENT & SIMULTANEOUSLY:
 - INITIATED CPR
 - DIALED 9-1-1 FOR HELP
 - RETRIEVED THE LIFESTYLES AED TO THE PATIENT'S LOCATION & APPLIED THE CHEST PADS
 - EXERCISED CROWD CONTROL & MOVED FURNITURE
 - WAITED IN PARKING LOT FOR & DIRECTED PARAMEDICS STRAIGHT TO THE PATIENT
- PATIENT REGAINED PULSE & RESPIRATIONS & WAS TAKEN TO THE HOSPITAL WHERE HE CONTINUED TO RECOVER & WAS RELEASED
- E.P.C. MEMBERS WORKED CALMLY & PROFESSIONALLY AS A TEAM!
